BUSAD 533 Economics and Business Decision Tools. (3-0). Cr. 3.  
 BusAd 533 was in the 2009 catalog with the exact description as proposed for the new catalog. It was not in the 2011 catalog, but we are unable to find out how and why it was removed.

FIN 535 Venture Capital, Private Equity, and Mergers and Acquisitions. (3-0). Cr. 3.  
 This course delves into detail in several topics in investment banking and corporate restructuring that are only touched upon in other finance classes. Topics include the nature and scope of investment banking, techniques for valuing public and private firms, venture capital finance, private equity finance, the role of hedge funds, leveraged buyouts, the goals and process of mergers and acquisitions, and divestitures. The goal is to provide not only a comprehensive overview of these important topics, but to give a framework for evaluating and implementing large-scale investments in real assets.
