X. JUSTIFICATION FOR NEW COURSES (attach Excel spreadsheet)

VDPAM 421 and 422: VDPAM 421 and 422 with a number of new topics each were added to facilitate the scheduling and course listing processes. All of these courses have been offered as topics in the VDPAM 482: Applied Beef Production Medicine Preceptorship. However, this practice became confusing to students and staff alike, so the new courses were created.

VCS 422 Rotation at Blank Park Zoo. This course was added to fill a need for more zoo and exotics experiences for our veterinary students.

VCS 471 C. Animal Reproduction C. Comparative. This topic was created to provide a meaningful learning experience to students who take the Animal Reproduction rotation during times of the year when there is not a seasonal species-specific surge in case numbers. During such times, students are exposed to a variety of species.
